WHO ARE THE ULTRAS?

- hardcore football fans. The phenomenon and expression originated in Italy in the late 1960s and spread across south-eastern Europe in the 1980s.
- characterized by strong organization and often an association to a political ideology. Sometimes, political and football passions, combined with a kind of tribal attachment to a particular neighborhood or city, trigger violence, particularly against other ultras groups.
- **not all ultras are violent**. Groups in the region promote art and poetry or provide social and humanitarian assistance.
- ultras are not always hooligans. hooliganism-based violence perpetrated by ultras group members is often the reason why some devoted fans leave their groups



WHO ARE THE HOOLIGANS?

- definitions of Cambridge and Oxford dictionaries: "behavior of a violent person who fights or causes damage in public places" or "a violent or rowdy behavior by young troublemakers, typically in a gang" applied to football spaces.
- violence is carried out by a group ("typically in a gang")—the "hooligans" are usually referred to in the plural.
- In the WB6, the group-dynamic of hooligans is closely linked to the characteristics of ultras.
- 'cover-all sense meant to represent a rather violent section of ultras, organized in groups which manifest an extremist ethnic, religious, or political identity through the use of verbal and/or physical violence, and through activities causing 'harm' of different kinds and extents to society including the commission of crimes (both petty and organized).

• Criterium 1 - Do members of this ultras group engage in particularly violent behaviours? (+5 SUBQUESTIONS)

Criterium 2 - Do members of this ultras group manifest/display an extremist political view?
(+4 SUBQUESTIONS)

Criterium 3 - Do members of this group commit any crime in relation to the group activity?
(+3 SUBQUESTIONS)






FIGURE 8 groups in the Western Balkan 6 with links to violence, politics and crime.
