Despite comprehensive measures to reduce dependence on Russian energy supplies following the Russian invasion of Ukraine on 24 February 2022, Germany's economy and democracy remain vulnerable to Russian infiltration. A recent study by the FNF shows the extensive networks of influence that Russia has built up over many years and analyses the strategies and mechanisms with which the Kremlin continues to manipulate politics and public opinion in Germany. The panel discussion will focus on how Moscow is weakening Germany's institutional autonomy, democratic resilience and political resolve and how we can defend ourselves against this.
