OBJECTIVES:

Objective of the training is to leverage the CSD's knowledge on both corruption and organized crime methodology and to train the selected group of public institutions' administration responsible for anti-corruption and organized crime legislation and measures with relevant tools and methods.

Corruption is intimately related to organized crime and tackling the two issues together is important for the long-term sustainability of anti-corruption efforts. CSD's experts will introduce Bulgaria's experience and monitoring mechanisms and help facilitate a discussion on applicability of such mechanisms to the situation in the Republic of Macedonia. An important aspect of such knowledge transfer will be the opportunities for using EU membership prospects more effectively to achieve anti-corruption efficiency.
